«Singing Bridges» Sound Show

Show "Singing Bridges" is a non-profit cultural and educational project, launched in 2016. The musical accompaniment begins a few seconds before the start of the raising of the Palace Bridge. The concept of the acoustic show is an open-air philharmonia. The project presents the art of Leningrad and St. Petersburg composers, which became symbols of the era, the country and the city. Playlists are in weekly rotation, and the playing time is 20-25 minutes.

Festival of light is a unique large-scale show dedicated to the image of St. Petersburg as one of the leading light design capitals in the world. The storyline is presented with the intertwined transitions of the visualizations of such topics as the history of St. Petersburg and the history of Russia. . Every year St. Petersburg's largest venues become facades for a 3D projection show: St. Petersburg Arena stadium and a pedestrian area in front of its main entrance, St. Isaac's Square, the facade of the St. Petersburg Legislative Assembly Hall and others.



XLIV International readings «Dostoevsky and the world culture»
